EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOOL:

- Incorporate poetry recitation into English/Language Arts curriculum (at teacher's discretion).
- Apply for Poets in Schools Grant Funds (optional). For more information see http://ndpol.weebly.com/poets-in-schools-grant.html.
- Hold classroom/school competitions by February 1, 2020 to determine school champion.
- Ensure School Champion attends State POL Competition on Monday, February 24, 2020, and National POL Competition (if selected) in Washington DC. (Date to be determined.)
- Submit all required forms to NDCA by indicated deadlines.
- Communicate effectively and in a timely manner with POL Coordinator and NDCA staff.
- Complete online teacher survey by March 15, 2020. (Link to survey will be shared following State POL Competition.)

EXPECTATIONS OF NDCA:

- Provide free curriculum materials to teachers, including teacher's guide, CD and poetry anthologies (when available).
- Provide up to \$2,000 to participating schools for Poets in Schools. Details found at http://ndpol.weebly.com/poets-in-schools-grant.html.
- Provide travel stipend of \$100 to schools residing one hundred miles outside Bismarck/Mandan metropolitan area.
- Provide travel stipend of \$150 to schools residing more than one hundred miles outside of Bismarck/Mandan metropolitan
 area.
- Present certificate of participation to each student who participates in the state competition.
- Provide first runner-up with a \$100 award and \$200 to his/her school for the purchase of poetry books.
- Present traveling trophy to state winner to be displayed in his/her school for one year.
- Provide state champion with a \$200 award; a \$500 stipend to his/her school for the purchase of poetry books; and an all-expense paid trip (with adult chaperone) to Washington, DC, to compete in National POL Competition.
- Provide state champion with consultation services prior to National competition (dependent upon availability of funds).
